



PSA Testing

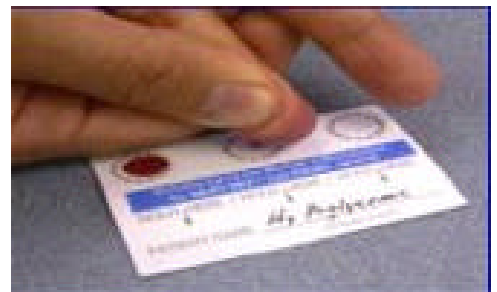
Since prostate cancer is the second most common cancer found in men in the United States, occurring in about 1 out of 10 men during their lifetime, annual PSA testing is a significant service you can offer every one of your male patients over the age of 50. Men in high-risk groups, such as African Americans and those with blood relatives who have had prostate cancer, should definitely begin testing by age 40 and may be in need of more frequent testing.

As you know, the best overall screen for prostate disease consists of the combination of a PSA test and a Digital Rectal Exam. But even without the DRE, many cases of prostate cancer will be discovered through the use of a PSA test alone. Elevated levels of PSA are an important signal of possible prostate cancer.

BioSafe's Prostrate Screen is a laboratory test that measures a chemical substance produced by the prostate gland called the Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) This Prostate Screen was developed using the Hybritech-Tandem PSA assay (the accepted industry Gold-Standard) and is still the only one of its kind available.

This dry spot blood test can be used in two ways. For the Physician, it provides an easy and convenient way for you to get CLIA certified lab results in your office. For Hospitals, Pharmacies, and Public Screening Companies, it provides a way to test individuals in a screening setting and then have the results mailed directly to the participant.

This easy test only requires a few drops of blood taken from a simple fingerstick. The blood is deposited on to a **Special Collection Card** and then shipped to BioSafe for analysis. The results are then faxed back to the physician or a very easy-to-read lab report is mailed to the screening participant.
